Lookout respects intellectual property rights and expects its users to do the same. If you believe that your work has been copied in a way that constitutes copyright infringement, or your intellectual property rights have been otherwise violated, please provide Lookout's Copyright Agent a notice containing the following information: (i) an electronic or physical signature of the person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright or other intellectual property interest that has allegedly been infringed; (ii) specific identification of each copyrighted work or other intellectual property that you claim has been infringed; (iii) identification of where the allegedly infringement material resides on the Lookout Service, (please be as detailed as possible and include an URL where applicable); (iv) contact information for the complaining party, including name, address, telephone number and email address; (v) a statement by you that you have a good faith belief that the disputed use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law; and (vi) a statement by you that the above information in your notice is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, that you are the copyright or intellectual property owner or authorized to act on the copyright or intellectual property owner's behalf.
